## **Katy Trail Extension, Phase VI, Dallas, TX**

The Katy Trail is the premier hike and bike trail in Dallas, Texas. Phase IV is nearing completion and is currently under DART's final review. Phase VI will provide an impressive signature bridge extension of the trail over Mockingbird Lane with connections to Mockingbird Station. Combined, these new trail extensions will add more than four miles to the existing KATY system and will connect McCommas Boulevard at US 75 to the White Rock DART Station at the northern end of White Rock lake.

Services included:
